

TOWN OF PROCTOR, VERMONT NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF TRAFFIC AND PARKING ORDINANCE

On November 10, 2025, the Selectboard of the Town of Proctor, Vermont, adopted amendments to the existing Traffic and Parking Ordinance Pursuant to the provisions of Title 23, Vermont Statutes Annotate, Sections 1007 and 1008, and Title 24, Vermont Statutes Annotated Sections 1971 and 2291 (1), (4) and (5). This notice is published pursuant to 24 V.S.A. §1973 to inform the public of these amendments and of the citizens' right to petition for a vote to disapprove these amendments.

SUMMARY OF AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE

Purpose: To correct highway numbers and street names, as well as define streets where no parking is allowed, or is limited for a period of time.

Principal Provisions

Article II - Scope

Sec. 2 Public highways within the Town of Proctor are:

- Town Highway 4 – West Street
- Town Highway 9 – Main Street
- Town Highway 10 -West Street
- Town Highway 11 – North Street
- Town Highway 18 – Charles Street North leg
- Town Highway 20 – Cross Street
- Town Highway 25 – School Street
- Town Highway 26 – Gibbs Street
- Town Highway 27 – Taylor Hill
- Town Highway 45 – Park Street
- Town Highway 53 – Terrace Hill South leg
- Town Highway 55 – Loop Street
- Town Highway 59 – Cliff Street
- Town Highway 61 – Olympus Road Extension

Article IV – Speed Regulations

Sec. 1 On the basis of engineering and traffic studies, the following speed limits are hereby established:

- a. T.H. #56 (South Street Extension – Old Rt. 3) and #55 (Loop Street): A maximum speed of 35 mpg for the entire length.

Article VI – Stop and Yield Intersections

Sec. 1 The following intersections shall be designated as stop intersections and shall be so signed:

- a. T.H. #1 (East Street) entering T.H. #9 Main Street (in front of Library)
- b. T.H. #3 (Main Street) intersecting with T.H. #9 Main Street (in front of Library)
- c. T.H. #10 (West Street) intersecting with T.H. #10 Beaver Pond Road 2-way stop
- d. T.H. #10 (West Street) intersecting with T.H. #2 (Cross Street)
- e. T.H. #25 (School Street) intersecting with T.H. #26 (Gibbs Street), 2-way stop
- f. T.H. #41 (Reynolds Street) entering T.H. #1 (South Street)
- g. T.H. #53 (Terrace Hill) entering T.H. #11 (North Street)
- h. T.H. #56 (South Street Ext. – Old Rt. 3) entering T.H. #1 (Route 3), at north and south intersections
- i. T.H. #55 (Loop Street) entering T.H. #1 (Route 3), at north and south intersections

Article VII Parking

Sec. 1 No person owning, operating or controlling a vehicle shall park, or cause to be parked such vehicle on the following street or portion of said street, or in town owned parking lots.

- a. T.H. #1 (East Street) between the intersection of T.H. #9 (Main Street) and T.H. #1 (East Street) and the intersection of T.H. #1 (East Street) and T.H. #31 (Field Street).
- b. T.H. #50 (Cain Street) between the intersection of T.H. #50 (Cain Street) and T.H. # 10 (West Street) and the west end of T.H. #50 (Cain Street).
- c. T.H. #10 (Beaver Pond Road) West side of the pond for on/offloading off-road vehicles, no parking vehicles and trailers for over one hour, and no overnight parking. This does not apply to fishing off shore or ice fishing, where vehicles may be parked for extensive duration.
- d. T.H. #44 (Park Street) East side from High School driveway entrance, North along tennis courts to the intersection of T.H #40 (Olympus Road), T.H. #17 (Grove Street and T.H. #39 (Warner Avenue).

CITIZENS' RIGHT TO PETITION FOR VOTE

Title 24 V.S.A. §1973 grants the citizens the right to petition for a vote at a special or annual Town Meeting to disapprove ordinance amendments adopted by the Selectboard. To exercise this right, citizens must present to the Selectboard or the Town Clerk a petition for a vote on the question of disapproving the amendments signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the Town's qualified voters. The petition must be presented within forty-four (44) days following the date of the adoption of the amendments. Unless a petition requesting a vote is filed pursuant to 24 V.S.A. §1973, the amended Traffic Ordinance shall become effective sixty (60) days from the date of said adoption.
