# STATE STATUEES REGARDING FIREWORKS

## 20 V.S.A } 3132. PROHIBITIONS; PERMITS

(d) Application for permits shall be made to the chief of the fire department, or in municipalities with no fire department, the select board, in writing, at least 15 days in advance of the date of the display. After the permit has been granted, sales, possessions, use and distribution of fireworks for the display shall be lawful for that purpose only. No permit granted under this section shall be transferable.

## 20 V.S.A. } 3134. SEIZURE

The state fire marshal, his or her deputy, a state police, a sheriff, a deputy sheriff, police officer, or constable may seize such articles held by a person in violation of this subchapter and hold the same subject to the order of the court taking jurisdiction of the offense.

## 20 V.S.A } 3135. PENALTIES

Any person, firm, co-partnership, or corporation that:

- (1) Violates this subchapter shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 for each violation or imprisoned for not more than 30 days or both.
