# 31 North Street Site Plan Review

- 3) Explain how the development will not impact the town owned sanitary sewer main that passes through the property
- 4) Designate hours of operation for the site. An example includes what time of the day/night material will be moved on and off the property
- 5) Include a construction timeline/phasing for site development to include fencing, surfacing, etc.
- 6) Submit answers to these comments on or by May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
