- II. Agenda approved and last meeting minutes approved
- III. Mortimer Proctor Grant Funding
  - A. There is a meeting on Friday for all who submitted applications
    - 1. Rachel and Amanda will attend, and we should know by next meeting if we were approved for anything
- IV. Ice Skating End of Season update
  - A. Overall it was a successful first season
  - B. The rink was open 26 days this winter, and had about 1000 visitors sign in
  - C. Lots of out of towners visited this season, and were impressed and shocked to find such a nice spot for their families for free. They gave lots of positive feedback after their visits.
  - D. Donations for the winter totaled \$700
  - E. The zamboni is working and the current ice managers were given a tutorial on the machinery from the previous ice manager
- V. Roller Skating
  - A. Trees need to be trimmed first, and that is already scheduled
  - B. Shooting to open for May, hopefully sooner. That will be weather dependent
  - C. The rink plans to be open for as many hours as possible this summer. This will be easier with more volunteers
  - D. During bad weather, the directors plan to host indoor movie nights
  - E. The rink plans to work with the local camps, and accommodate earlier hours if possible so they can bring the kids during the day
  - F. Plan to ask for students to help during Green up Day on April 30.

  - C. More lifeguards needed. Must be age 15 and take the class
  - D. Lifequard class is end of May into June through the Rutland Rec
