Chairman's Report:

Swimming Area:

Committee explored the idea of installing signs to restrict fishing at the beach area along Beaver Pond Road. There was concern over whether the rule would be enforced appropriately, and whether it aligned with the existing language in the Beaver Pond ordinance. Wood Sculpture:

Jim Moore has offered to carve a wood sculpture out of the trunk at the picnic area for no fee. Berry Pinske offered to make a carving for \$650, and the stump would need to be dropped off at his property. Tom Hogan made the motion and seconded by Ray Beyette to have Jim Moore design and produce a carving on site. Unanimously approved.

Maintenance & Improvements:

Ray Beyette is making a stencil to mark existing equipment to mitigate theft. A metal bench from the picnic area will be placed at the swimming area. Ray had found a couple of glass bottles around the property. Tom Hogan made the motion and seconded by Pauline Hogan to install a wooden sign with the words "Beaver Pond Picnic Area" at the entrance off of Florence Road. Unanimously approved.
